Weber Oslo Cup is very proud to be part of the World Curling Tour - Europe.

THE MEN'S CUP

The Men's Cup is open for 20 teams which will play in 4 groups of 5 teams. The total purse is NOK 150.000,- (Can \$ 30.000,-). The winning team gets NOK 54.000,-. Prize money will be awarded to the best 8 teams.

THE WOMEN'S CUP

The Women's Cup is open for 16 teams which will play in 4 groups of 4 teams. The total purse is NOK 60,000,- and the winning team gets NOK 16,000,-. Prize money will be awarded to the best 8 teams.

PLAYING SYSTEM

The best two teams from each group will play in the quarter finals, where the top ranked teams will play a second ranked team from another group. The losers of quarterfinals will be ranked 5th, and the losers of the semifinals ranked 3rd.

All the matches will be played over 8 ends, and according to the WCF rules.

The organising committee reserves the right to change the format of the tournament depending of the number of entries.

FAIR PLAY AWARD

The players will vote for the fellow competitor to receive The Canadian Embassy Fair Play Award.

SCHEDULE

The first matches start Thursday morning at 10:00 hrs, but the organising committee will try to be flexible with teams arriving late. The finals are played on Sunday at 16:00 hrs. Presentation of prizes at 18:15 hrs.

ENTRY FEES

Entry Fee is NOK 4.000,- pr. team in the men's cup and NOK 2.500,- in the women's cup, and includes all the social events listed below.

Entries must be received before August 6th. and confirmed by paying the entry fee to our bank account #6201.05.38292 within August 19th.

ACCOMODATION

Accommodation can be arranged at Radisson SAS Park Hotel at NOK 350,- pr. night in double rooms including breakfast.

LOCATION

Snarøya Curling Arena is located 10 minutes drive from Oslo centre. The distance from Gardemoen Airport to Oslo centre is 40 km, but an express train, with six departures an hour, takes you to Oslo Central Station in about 20 minutes. Every second train continues to a station nearby the players hotel where local transportation will be provided.
